THE C	city of Ephiesus
1.	A natural juncture for maritime and rural trade. Provincial capital of Roman Asia Minor
2.	Twenty-five thousand seat amphitheatre
3.	Grand temple of Artermis (Diana) mother goddess (Acts 19)
4.	Other temples (Ephesus enjoyed the title <i>neokoros</i> , 'temple warden' of the imperial cult. Civic events such as Artemesia in spring, games linked the major cults of the city with the major social events of the province.
5.	Home to a significant Jewish community. This community was given permission to follow its ethnic customs, exemption from military service and permission to send money to Jerusalem for support of the sacrificial system there.
